Mary Kathryn has been a genealogist for over 30 years. Over the years her research has focused on the United States and both Western and Eastern Europe. Mary currently serves on the Jewish Genealogical Society of Washington State board. She also coordinates five USGenWeb counties, and teaches seminars to whoever will listen! She has earned a second bachelor's degree in Information Technology and Systems and has started serving as a part-time FamilySearch.org Support Missionary for the LDS Church.

Dave Obee is the Editor-in-Chief of the "Times Colonist" in Victoria, B.C., a contributing columnist for "Internet Genealogy Magazine" and "Family Chronicle Magazine". He has written a dozen books on both history and genealogy and given over 400 presentations in the U.S. and Canada since 1997. Dave has received numerous awards for his historical research, community volunteerism, and professional journalism. He has visited 17 European countries conducting genealogy research. He is a past-president of the Federation of East European Family History Societies and continues his service as FEEHS' webmaster.
