Mary currently serves on the Jewish Genealogical Society of Washington State board. She also coordinates five USGenWeb counties, and teaches seminars to whoever will listen! She has earned a second bachelor's degree in Information Technology and Systems and has started serving as a part-time FamilySearch.org Support Missionary for the LDS Church.

Dave Obee is the Editor-in-Chief of the "Times Colonist" in Victoria, B.C., a contributing columnist for "Internet Genealogy Magazine" and "Family Chronicle Magazine". He has written a dozen books on both history and genealogy and given over 400 presentations in the U.S. and Canada since 1997.
